## **BILL RAFTERY**

Bill joined FOX Sports prior to the 2013-14 season, the network's first covering of college basketball and the first season of the newly aligned BIG EAST Conference. A veteran analyst with playing and coaching experience, his keen analysis and opinion are accompanied by unsurpassed enthusiasm and unique catchphrases like "Onions!" and "With a kiss!"

Before joining FOX Sports, he spent 32 years covering basketball as an analyst on television and radio for CBS, ESPN and CBS Radio.

Bill began his broadcasting career in 1982 with ESPN, where he served as a game analyst for college basketball through the 2012 season. From 1970-81, he was the head basketball coach at Seton Hall, where he revitalized the program and led the Pirates to seven straight winning seasons. Bill also served as president of the BIG EAST Coaches Association from 1979-81. Prior to his time at Seton Hall, he coached five years at Fairleigh Dickinson, earning Coach of the Year honors from the New Jersey Basketball Writers Association in his final season with the program.

A standout on the court as well as coach's bench and broadcast booth, Bill Raftery played three seasons at LaSalle under legendary coach Donald "Dudley" Moore. During the 1959-60 season, he set a freshman scoring record with 370 points. Following his senior campaign, he was drafted by the New York Knicks.

Bill earned a degree in history from LaSalle and a master's in education from Seton Hall. He was given an Honorary Doctorate from LaSalle in 2001 and serves as the president of W.J. Raftery Associates, an events/marketing firm.

## INAUGURAL SAINT AUGUSTINE MEDAL RECIPIENTS PATTY AND JAY WRIGHT

ATTY WRIGHT is a Cherry Hill, N.J. native who received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Villanova University in 1983. During her days as a Villanova student she was a member of the Wildcats' cheerleading squad. In 1989 she earned a J.D. degree from the Widener School of Law (today known as the Delaware School of Law).

Jay and Patty Wright met while working in the marketing department of the Philadelphia Stars of the United States Football League in 1984. The couple was married in 1991 and have three children: son Taylor, a 2015 graduate of Brown University; son Collin, a 2016 graduate of Fordham University; and daughter Reilly, who will enroll at the University of Pennsylvania in the fall of 2017.

Since returning to Villanova in 2001, the Wrights have been active members of the Villanova community and supportive of its Augustinian mission. During their time at Villanova, the Wrights have helped foster the family culture around the men's basketball program that they came to know while part of the program under Coach Rollie Massimino from 1987–92.

VER THE COURSE OF 16 SEASONS as head coach, Jay Wright has guided Villanova to a period of unprecedented success on the national stage. Over the last four seasons (2013–17) the Wildcats posted a 129–17 (.884) overall record that included four consecutive BIG EAST regular season championships, two BIG EAST Tournament crowns (2015 and '17) and the 2016 NCAA national championship.

Wright is a five time winner of the BIG EAST Coach of the Year award (2006, 2009, 2014, 2015, 2016) and a two-time recipient of the Naismith National Coach of the Year award (2006 and 2016). He was a finalist for the 2017 Naismith National Coach of the Year honor.

The Wildcats captured the 2016 NCAA national title with a pulsating 77–74 victory over North Carolina on April 4, 2016 when Kris Jenkins drained a 3-pointer on the game's final play. Seated a few rows behind the Villanova bench at NRG Stadium that night was coach Rollie Massimino, who led the Wildcats to the school's first national championship in 1985 and two years later hired Wright as an assistant coach.

Wright has led Villanova to 12 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 13 seasons. His overall NCAA Tournament record is 21–13 (.618) and includes five visits to the NCAA Sweet 16, three trips to the Elite Eight, and two Final Four appearances (2009 and 2016).

On Feb. 11, 2017, Wright earned his 500th career win as the Wildcats defeated Xavier 73–57. His resume includes 122 victories posted at his first head coaching stop, Hofstra



University, from 1994-2001. Wright owns an overall career mark of 508–246 (.674), including 386–161 (.706) since assuming command at Villanova on March 27, 2001.

Every Villanova player who has spent four years in the program has earned his degree during Wright's tenure. Seven Wildcats brought to Villanova by Wright—including two-time NBA All-Star Kyle Lowry, Darrun Hilliard, Daniel Ochefu, Randy Foye, Dante Cunningham, Allan Ray and Maalik Wayns—have played in the National Basketball Association. Two of his former Hofstra players, Speedy Claxton and Norman Richardson, also played in the NBA.

In addition to its five BIG EAST regular seasons titles and two BIG EAST Tournament crowns captured since 2001–02, Villanova has won or shared 10 Philadelphia Big Five in that span. The Wildcats will take an 18-game City Series winning streak into 2017–18.

A 1983 Bucknell University graduate, Wright is married to the former Patricia Reilly. The couple has two sons, Brown University graduate Taylor (24) and Fordham University graduate Colin (23) and a daughter Reilly (18), who is slated to enroll at the University of Pennsylvania in the fall of 2017.

Wright's book, "Attitude: Develop a Winning Mindset On and Off the Court" was released in February 2017 and earned a spot on the *New York Times* Best Sellers List. He also joins forces with Philadelphia's other Division I head coaches in the fight against cancer through the Coaches vs. Cancer organization.

## THE PROVINCE of SAINT THOMAS of VILLANOVA ————

#### **OUR MISSION**

We Augustinians take our inspiration from the religious insight, example and teaching of Saint Augustine. We seek to live out Christ's mandate to love God and neighbor through our community life and in service to the Church. To seek God together is our common project. To share our discovery of God is our joint undertaking.

We call ourselves friars, that is, brothers, and our fraternity is demonstrated in the equality of us all, without distinctions on the basis of social, ethnic or economic differences. Unity of minds and hearts is our goal as well as our constant stimulus.

### WHO WE ARE

he Augustinian way of life was established in the United States just twenty years after the birth of our nation. In the last quarter of the 18th Century, two friars arrived from Ireland to assist here in the missionary work of the Church, with the intention to plant, as well, the seeds of the Order of Saint Augustine on this soil. Father Matthew Carr O.S.A., one of the two pioneers, sought funds to construct the first house and church of the Order, that of Saint Augustine in Philadelphia, just weeks after his arrival. Progress on construction was slow, but finally in 1801 it was ready for use. Slow, too, was the expansion of the Order, as American candidates were few. Nonetheless, with perseverance, hard work and spirited faith, growth did occur. In 1841 the friars purchased a 200 acre farm outside the city, and established there what was to become the center of Augustinian community life and ministry for a very long time thereafter, with the establishment of a novitiate to train prospective candidates and a friary in which to follow a conventional form of religious community life in the Augustinian tradition. Here, also, the friars opened a school for boys, from which grew two of our most significant ministries which still maintain our Augustinian values and continue our long tradition: Villanova University and Malvern Preparatory School.

With the eventual increase of new vocations, the United States branch of the Order achieved full stature as the Province of Saint Thomas of Villanova in the year 1874. Expansion continued into Massachusetts and New York State with new communities established to serve parishes in various dioceses and the founding of schools by the Province as well as the staffing of others founded by bishops. Friars ventured into the foreign mission field in Cuba and new foundations were made in Washington, D.C., Florida, and later in North Carolina, as well as in cities of the Midwest and Far West. As growth continued, two new Provinces were carved out of the Villanova Province, that of Our Mother of Good Counsel in 1941, centered in Chicago, and that of Saint Augustine in 1969, based in San Diego, and new missions were opened in Japan, Peru and South Africa.



### WHERE WE ARE

resently, the Province of Saint Thomas of Villanova is comprised of 161 members, 88 of whom are actively engaged in ministry in schools, parishes or other works. 47 are retired or infirm, 11 are full-time students and 12 are engaged in training our newest members, serve the Province in internal ministries, or are missionaries.

As Augustinian religious, we choose not to define ourselves only, nor primarily, by what we do, but rather by who we are and how we live. And so, we form local communities, usually of three or four or five friars, though our largest community counts 50 members.




## The Augustinian Guild
